Howard Duncan, school captain, has had a distinguished career in medicine spanning half a century. After leaving school, he studied at the University of Sydney (M.B., B.S.), training at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital in Sydney, and the University of Minnesota (M.Sc.Med.). He has worked in hospitals in Australia, United Kingdom and later United States of America. He is a fellow of the American college of Physicians, the Royal College of Physicians of London and the American College of Rheumatology.

His hospital appointments and research has been largely in the area of rheumatology and Orthopaedics and he became a leading exponent having written over eighty publications and as many articles on the topic. His renowned senior appointments have included Head of Rheumatology at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit (1982-1995) and Clinical Professor of Internal Medicine at the University of Michigan (1977-1995). He has also worked in the world-renowned Mayo Clinic in Minneapolis.
