Peter specialises in the analysis on Win32 malware, reverse engineering code on multiple platform development of emulators and unpackers, and detection on virtual machines.

He has also contributed to leading journals in the industry such as Virus Bulletin Journal. In 2001 he joined Computer Anti-Virus Research Organisation and has several software-related patents.
