Todd Greenberg (1983-1988) captained the first XI cricket team which won the Davidson Shield. As a first-grade cricketer he played for Randwick Cricket Club for ten seasons. He obtained a Bachelor of Sports Science from UNSW and Master in Sport Management at UTS.

In 1993 Todd became Development and Promotions Officer with Cricket NSW and then Operations Manager in 1995. In 2011 he joined Ogden IFC at Stadium Australia as the Events and Operations Manager, then eventually the position of General Manager. Between 2001 and 2008 he was part of the Stadiums management team which organised such events as NRL grand finals, State of Origin, Bledisloe Cup, Soccer World Cup qualification matches and several concerts such as U2, The Rolling Stones and The Police.

In March 2008, Todd joined the Bulldogs Rugby League Club as the Chief Executive Officer, after fifteen years in the sports and venue management industry and in 2021, he was appointed as Chief Executive Officer of the Australian Cricketers' Association.
