John Morrison, 1944-1948, attended Sydney Teachers College and then universities in Queensland and NSW, finally completing his Ph.D at the university of New England in 1985. His career in education spanned almost fifty years from when he began teaching Mathematics in 1951 until he became Principal of Lurnea High School in 1981-1985 and Heathcote 1986-1989. He then moved on to become a lecturer in education at University of New South Wales 1989-1999 where he taught educational administration, philosophy and sociology of education, sports science and professional ethics. He has published several articles in educational journals as well as books on education, philosophy and sport.

John is a keen musician, chorister, sportsman and family man.

He is the official historian of Sydney Technical high School, compiling a history of the school to be published in the centenary year 2011. This is a five-year project which commenced in 2005. John is often seen around the school interviewing members of the school community and researching our records since 1911.
