Andrew Pesce (1972-1978) graduated from UNSW as an MBBS in 1983 and then worked at Westmead Hospital, training in obstetrics and gynaecology. He then completed his specialist training at St. Bartholomew's and Whipps Cross Hospitals in London, specialising in endoscopic gynaecological surgery. He was awarded the Australian Gynaecological Endoscopic Society Presidents Prize in 1992.

Andrew returned in 1993 as Staff Specialist at Westmead Hospital and then as Visiting Obstetrician and Gynaecologist from 2003. He was served on the AMA Federal Council and Executive Council and received the AMA Presidents Prize for service to the medical profession. Dr. Pesce is currently the Chairman of the National association of Specialist Obstetricians and Gynaecologists, Clinical Director Women's Health Sydney West Area Health Service and Chairman of the Federal Government Expert Advisory Committee on Early Pregnancy Counselling.
