Bruce Robinson, 1969-1974, school captain, graduated from the University of Sydney and was also awarded a doctorate in medicine. He also attended Harvard Medical School. He is currently an endocrinologist and head of the Cancer Genetics Laboratory in the Kolling Institute. He is also Head of the Division of Medicine at Royal North Shore Hospital, as well as Associate Dean (international) of the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Sydney.

Professor Robinson was awarded the Daiichi Prize by the Asia and Oceania Thyroid Associations for his work on the pathogenesis of thyroid cancer. He serves on the Council of the Endocrine Society of Australia and is Founding Chairman of Hoc Mai, the Australia Vietnam Medical Foundation. Which sponsors and supports medical, nursing, allied health and scientific exchanges between Australia and Vietnam.
