

BRUCE SHARP Class of 1945

Bruce McLeod Sharp was a member of the Sydney YMCA Champion Gymnastics Team 1951-1963 and has competed for New South Wales in thirteen national championships. He was state champion in 1956, 1958 and 1959 and then gained a place in the Australian champion team in 1959, 1960 and 1961. He has been a member of the New South Wales Amateur Gymnastics Association for twenty-one years as well as serving as team captain and coach. In 2000 Bruce was recognized in the award of the Australian Sports Medal for his services to gymnastics.

Bruce studied Fine Arts at the National Art School and has pursued a fifty-year career as a graphic artist and photographer. He has also served the community as a member of Rotary International since 1960, including presidency of the Rockdale Rotary Club 1984-1985 and the award of the Rotary Harris Fellowship in 1989.
