Reg Smart (1940-1944) attended Sydney Technical College after leaving Sydney Technical High School, after qualifying in 1951 as an architect and having one of his designs featured on the cover of *The Australian Home Beautiful* he worked as one of a four-architect team designing Singapore's first international airport.

Theological and social justice interests led to Methodist ordination in 1960 and completion of a doctorate in Social Ethics at Boston University in 1964 while working as a Harvard chaplain. In 1965, Reg received The Creative Individuals Award at Harvard. He was professor of Interpersonal and Intercultural Communication for twenty-one years: his work has included relationships between men and women and between numerous social groups, dispute resolution, intercultural communication. As a business consultant has trained over three thousand managers in negotiation skills in three countries.

In 2004, he published a novel *Intimate Strangers*.
