

BRYAN SNAPE

Brian Snape (1949-1953) worked for BP Australia Ltd for 31 years in several roles, finally being appointed a member of the Board in 1983 - 1992. He advocated the company's funding of the Australian Bird Count (1990 - 1993). He was chairman of BP Solar, 1990 - 1992. Brian fulfilled the roles of Trustee, Committee for the Economic Development of Australia (CEDA), 1983 - 1992 and then Chairman of the Trustee Relations Committee. 1995 - 2001.

Once retiring from BP Australia in 1992, he was involved with a number of environmental organizations in voluntary roles: Chairman of Trust for Nature 1992 - 2002; National Council member 1993 -1998 and President 1995 -1997 of Birds Australia.

In June 2005 Brian was appointed a Member of the Order of Australia (AM) for vice to conservation and the environment, particularly through Trust for Nature (Victoria) and Birds Australia.
