

STEPHEN WOOLDRIDGE - OAM

Class of 1995

Stephen Woolridge was an Olympic Games cyclist who won a Gold Medal at the 2004 Athens Games and was a four-time world champion on the track. Whilst following the sport of his dreams, Stephen also completed a degree in engineering and a Bachelor of Technology Management in Manufacturing.

Stephen was a school prefect in his final year at Sydney technical Highschool, 1995.

Representing Australia brought him numerous medals, including gold (1st place) at the 2002 Commonwealth Games in Melbourne. At Cycling World Championships, he was a member of teams which won four gold and one bronze from 2002 to 2005. In 2007, Stephen won the first stage of the Tour of Siam (Thailand).

Stephen receives a gold medal for his efforts as part of the six cyclists making up the four-man Pursuit Team at the 2004 Olympic Games and was a warded an OAM (Order of Australia medal) in 2005.

Stephen presented awards to his School's elite sportsmen at Sydney technical High School Sports Presentation in 2010 bringing along his treasured gold medal for all to see.

Tragically, Stephen died in 2017.
